
Three Days Teacher Orientation Programme

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
Day2

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
Day3


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
Objectives of the Orientation Program:

Dr. Shamla V Datta, the chief Guest of the function, introduced the topic of National Education Policy 2020 and cited that it has four parts –




1. School Education

In Multidisciplinary institutions, a student can study any two unrelated subject. Reconstructing of our curriculum has been made mandatory. By 2030, a Four year Teacher Education will be realized. NEP has a holistic approach and is value based policy.

3. Knowledge as application


All Three are interdependent.

There are two issues for B. Ed teacher in NEP. They are –


1. Challenge

Old jobs, old Schemes, old as slow working systems have been vanished, as per the modern needs specific skill qualification and fast working system one placed.


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





Topic-Communication and Soft Skills


Due to the shortage of qualified faculty, inadequate resource and infrastructure to teach, “MOOCS” – Massive open online course gained popularity.







"Enrichment of Teaching Skills and Strategies"



"Overview of Specific Learning Disabilities"



Therefore, guidance was given on how to identify students with different abilities (e.g Gifted, Slow, Learning Disabilities) and how to teach them according to their abilities. Also various experts were guided on how to design and follow the assessment process for differently abled students according to the student.

The two-day orientation program was guided by various experts from Guru Nanak First Grade College Bidar. This guide provides useful guidance to all teachers and Teachers on how to implement teaching and assessment process for students with different learning ability.


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
