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
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1. Health Educational Awareness Program

Education: Integrate children's rights into school curricula and teach students about their rights from an early age. This helps them understand what they are entitled to and how to recognize when those rights are violated.



3. Leverages Local Environment




Natural Resources: These include minerals, water sources, forests, and other materials that occur naturally and are utilized for various purposes such as agriculture, industry, or energy production.


7. Participation in Vaccination Campaign
